From The Whyte House

I have recently started playing slow pitch softball again (because I need more exercise). It isn't anything big, usually 2 games 1 night per week. But I have noticed that my body doesn't treat me very nice for the next few days after I play which makes it hard to be motivated to do it again. But I was reading this scripture a few months back that reminded me of how my body works and more importantly how the body of Christ should work.

1 Corinthians 12:14-21 (NIV)¹⁴ Now the body is not made up of one part but of many.¹⁵ If the foot should say, "Because I am not a hand, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason cease to be part of the body.¹⁶ And if the ear should say, "Because I am not an eye, I do not belong to the body," it would not for that reason cease to be part of the body.¹⁷ If the whole body were an eye, where would the sense of hearing be? If the whole body were an ear, where would the sense of smell be?¹⁸ But in fact God has arranged the parts in the body, every one of them, just as he wanted them to be.¹⁹ If they were all one part, where would the body be?²⁰ As it is, there are many parts, but one body.²¹ The eye cannot say to the hand, "I don't need you!"

I need every part of my body to play softball and I feel every muscle and bone in my body after I play. But sometimes I get complacent or comfortable at where I am in life with the amount of exercise and diet and I find myself not feeling as well as I did when I was doing those things that my body needed. The same thing is true as the body of Christ. At times we feel that our relationship with God and our lives at church are ok and we get comfortable and our body needs us to continue pressing forward striving toward the goal of heaven and to take as many as we can with us. Paul reminds us in verse 27 of the same chapter in 1 Corinthians that we are the body of Christ and all of us are part of that body. I want to encourage us that even though it is summer and we may have become a little comfortable there are still areas within our body that need a "part."
