From the Whyte House

I wanted to take this opportunity to share with you about our new online giving opportunity. In September we launched online giving on our website. This is a very easy way to give to OCC. We decided to provide this opportunity for a few reasons. First, we understand that doing things online is convenient for some and has become a normal way to conduct business. Second, we have noticed that when our Sunday morning attendance drops so does our giving and though our attendance might go back up the following Sunday our giving doesn't necessarily follow the same pattern. So online giving allows us to give whether we are at church or not. Third, we know that life gets busy and you might be pressed for a certain church function deadline where monies are due on a certain date. Online giving allows us to make a one time payment (designated to whatever ministry/event) so that you are paid by the due date.

I know that, for some, this is a new and possibly scarey endeavour. Let me say this. You don't have to give to OCC through online giving. We will still be passing the offering plate and so you can still give a check or cash as the plate is passed. However, we have implemented this opportunity so that others who already conduct their financial business online or for those who would like the added convenience of being able to give online can do so.

The set up is very easy. Simply go to our website http://www.oakleychristianchurch.com/ and then head to the lower right corner of the page. There you will find a blue rectangle button that says, "Give Online" (there is also a "Give Online" link at the top of the web page under the "Get Involved" tab). Press that blue button and it will take you directly to our online giving page supported by Sharefaith. At this point you can Log in (if you have already created an account), you can register a new account or you can simply type in the type of gift (one time, recurring, etc.) that you would like to give and the amount that you would like to give as well as any comments that are needed to explain the specific gift. Then click next where you will be taken to a page where you can enter all of your banking information. We strongly encourage you to create an account so that our Treasurer can provide you with a summary of all your online giving.

I hope that this has helped make sense of the online giving opportunity that we are excited to share with everyone. I have also provided a direct link to the online giving page in case you are unable to locate it on our web page https://secure.sharefaithgiving.com/go/form.php?rid=e6c43b4f6d3e&






Full Circle Speaker Elena Hagemeier Saturday, October 14 1:30 PM Held at:

SPOTLIGHT

Each month at OCC, we will spotlight one of the 11 missions that we support. Information about all the missions/missionaries we support is also available on our website www.oakleychristianchurch.com under the MISSIONS tab. This months spotlight is Tri State Praise KGCR

KGCR's primary format is religious adult contemporary (MercyMe, Brandon Heath, Natalie Grant, Third Day, Casting Crowns). We currently air approximately 50% music and 50% informational and religious programs and news. We also offer a secondary signal, called a sub-carrier, that requires a special radio. Classic KGCR provides a mix of traditional hymns and lite southern gospel along with a variety of programs. KGCR is owned and operated by The Praise Network.

KGCR broadcasts 24-hours a day at 100,000-watts FM and is licensed in Goodland, Kansas. Our studio and transmitter are located 16 miles east of Goodland, near Brewster.

KGCR first went on the air in March of 1988. The station was started by Allen and Doris Quenzer and Herb Roszhart to support area churches and Christian ministries in meeting the spiritual needs of the tri-state area. The station was donated to The Praise Network on October 1, 1998.
