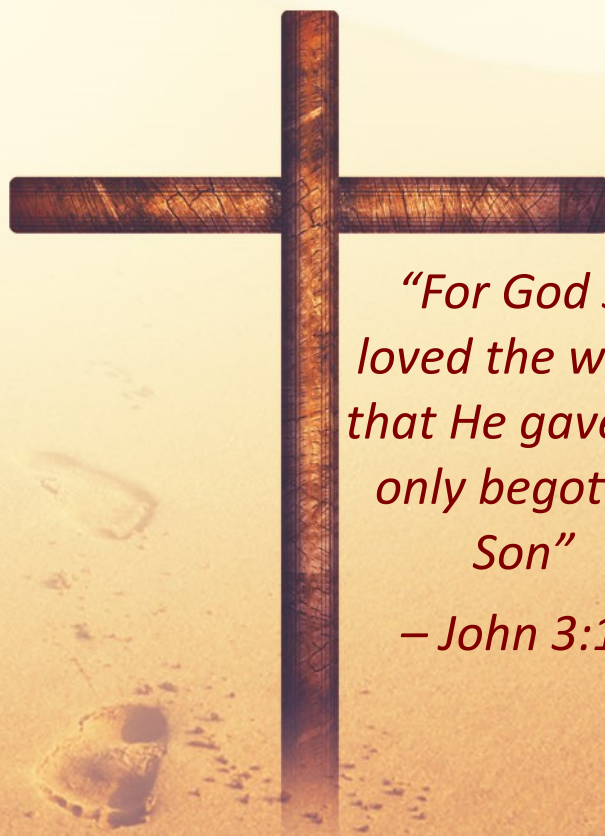


# Diaper/Freezer Meal Shower for The Kemp Family

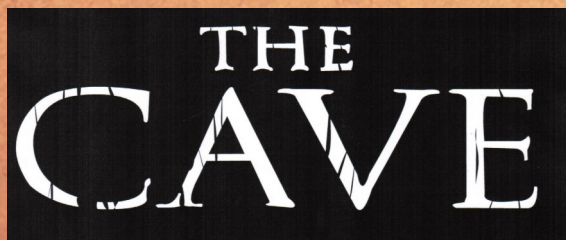
