Either way, God uses these things to bring us closer to Him so that we can bear more fruit. He is constantly pruning us to create in us the type of life that He desires. As you think about the spring and how what appears to be dead brings forth life, what is God taking that appears to be dead in you and pruning back so that you can grow in Him? How is He using those things that may be unpleasant to yield a more fruitful life? I pray that as you see the colors unfold this spring that it will remind you of how God is unfolding His mighty plan in your life as He prunes you to produce fruit.






