We are a collection site for Operation Christmas Child once again! We are also the central drop off location for Northwest Kansas. On Monday, November 23rd, 12 different drop off locations will bring their cartons of shoeboxes to us and we will load them on the truck! The GOAL for Northwest Kansas this year is 9,500 shoeboxes! We collected 8,715 shoeboxes last year and Oakley collected just over 200 shoeboxes! We have free GO boxes here at the church for you to take and fill this year! You can also share these boxes with anyone in Oakley that would like to pack a shoebox! We will offer curbside pick up this year due to covid - you can bring your boxes during National Collection Week (November 16-23) from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm and we will meet you in the parking lot to pick up your boxes for you! You can also bring them to church on November 15 or 22!
