
During this small group (Wednesdays at 6:30 pm), we will come together and watch a short video and then discuss the weeks lesson over the book of Philippians.

The book of Romans underscores that Christianity is far more than just a doctrine - it is an essential roadmap for daily living.


We will be going for 9 weeks and will end on November 10th! We will be studying the Fruits of the Spirit!




PreK - 2nd grade meets on the Mid Level and this quarter Ginny Hornung is teaching!

Nursery - we will have various folks in the nursery to watch the littles during the Sunday School hour




A time of silent prayer is held every Tuesday from 9:15 am to 9:45 am in the church sanctuary.
