the ancestral land of these precious people. The Masai are a simple people who have no desire to be in conflict with anyone, they just want to be left alone to raise their families and livestock as they have for centuries. Thank you for your prayers and support, may God bless you as you pray!



Elders are men that are members of OCC, they direct the finances of the church, give spiritual oversight to all areas of the church and oversee individual ministries. These men act as the governing body of Oakley Christian Church.

Deacons are men that are members of OCC, these men give oversight to all maintenance for the church building, Cave, parsonage and grounds. These men are in charge of helping/serving the shut-ins, widows and widowers of our congregation.


