A great way to get to know and connect with others at OCC!

What is Tables of 8?

Tables of Eight is an opportunity for couples/singles to share a meal with others at Oakley Christian Church and get to know one another better. The emphasis of these gatherings is on fellowship so there's no accompanying bible study, nor is there an expectation of culinary perfection. Our goal is simply to get to know each other and meet with those we may not already know.

How does it work?

When you sign up, you will be placed in a table group. Each group will have a coordinator who will initiate the conversation to schedule your first dinner date. The dinner is provided by the whole group with each person being assigned a different dish, group members will rotate the opportunity to host as well. A great idea might be to have a "theme" for each meal, Italian, picnic, Mexican, etc. After the first dinner date, the group will continue to set dates that work for everyone and assign who brings what to each meal. The goal is to meet four times in four months (September, October, November, December).

What if I'm not a cook or a host?

There is no expectation of culinary perfection, it is okay to bring things purchased at a store. Similarly, if having people in your home is not going to work for you, someone else can host twice or you are welcome to use the church basement or The Cave (just get on the church or Cave calendar by calling the church office 785.672.3188 or texting Rhonda 785.953.7078).

What about kids?

We would like to keep the focus on adults gathering together, so this time around, no kids at the Tables of 8. We've got some great babysitters in our congregation, give them a call and enjoy an evening with just adults!

Can I choose who is in my group?

No, that's the fun of it! The goal is to get to know people you don't usually hang out with, and to make some new friends at OCC. Everyone is encouraged to participate! If you are married and your spouse does not want to participate but you do, sign up! If you are single, sign up! If you're a couple, sign up! Each group will have a mix of couples, singles, married w/o their spouse, and will be a total of 8 people (or close to it). The group will meet four times from September to December, it's up to your group to decide what works best for you (such as once in September, twice in October, once in November OR once each month, you get the idea, but the goal is to gather for a meal four times before the end of 2022!

Sign up by Sunday, September 11

Sign up via paper form (in the foyer) or google form and get those turned in by September 11. Groups will be announced the following Sunday, September 18th. From there, the coordinator of each group will initiate contact and the group will begin to make their plans about getting together for a meal four times before the end of 2022!

Adult 2 will be studying the book of James, there will be a study guide and discussion will be held.




